1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Chairman Bourdon called the meeting to order at 8:00 AM. Jean Knight, CYMPO Program Coordinator performed roll call.

Mr. Bridges related the 2013 meeting schedule is being presented; meetings need to be scheduled even if there is not a meeting that month. Additionally, because the meeting scheduled for January 3rd is a holiday week, it is proposed to move the meeting to January 9th. Ms. Knight explained the Executive Board is proposing to amend the by-laws as it states the TAC meetings adhere to the same rules as the Executive Board. The Executive Board proposed the M-TAC hold no less than 2-meetings per year; if the M-TAC concurs.

Mr. McConnell questioned why January 9th was determined for the next meeting. He brought up the subject of a change of venue for the meetings. Mr. Davis requested a change of venue of the M-TAC meetings to the Town of Prescott Valley Library Auditorium. Mr. Bourdon thought it would be fine to move the meetings; possibly annually; however, not monthly or quarterly.

Ms. Kimball requested clarification of the By-Laws; 2-meetings per year versus the schedule for meetings each month.

Vice Chairman Davis presented a motion to recommend the Executive Board amend the CYMPO By-Laws to reflect that at a minimum the M-TAC will hold 2-meetings annually; for staff to publicize the attached meeting schedule; to move the 2013 meetings to Town of Prescott Valley Auditorium; and, to move the January 3rd meeting to January 10th.
