CYMPO Administrator Chris Bridges explained; CYMPO had added transit items for 5310, 5316 and 5317 grants to our FY12-16 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP), at the request of the Arizona Department of Transportation, ADOT. After much deliberation, ADOT staff has made the determination that those items should be removed, due to internal accounting issues.
